**A RESOLUTION**

Relating to the appointment of students to the Presidential Charter Committees for 2022-2023.

**Section 1. Short Title**

This resolution may be titled as, “Confirmation of the Nominees for the Presidential Charter Committees for 2022-2023.”

**Section 2. Discussion**

**Whereas**, “Charter committees are established in an effort to assure that university-wide services and activities will be carried out in the best interests of education and society”<sup>1</sup>, and;

**Whereas**, “Appointees of the University of Iowa Student Government shall be persons who are currently registered as full-time students at the university in an undergraduate, graduate, or professional program on campus”, and;

**Whereas,** a Joint Nominations Committee comprised of Undergraduate Student Government (USG) Internal Affairs members and Graduate & Professional Student Government (GPSG) members are responsible for appointing student representatives to Presidential Charter Committees (PCC), and;

**Whereas,** USG and GPSG are also responsible for appointing student committee chairs where applicable and filling student positions that become available during a term, and;

**Whereas,** USG and GPSG have historically filled over 50 student representative positions in the spring to serve terms running from September to August of the following year;

**Whereas,** An application form was opened and available to the University of Iowa student body

**Whereas,** Candidates were selected by the Joint Nominations Committee based upon the application materials of a resume, cover letter, and an interview;

**Whereas,** An asterisk (\*) denotes a Student Chair for that committee;

**Whereas,** a third student was not selected for the Campus Planning committee and will be filled by USG and GPSG at a later date and;

**Whereas,** a professional student was not selected for the Committee on Diversity and will be filled by GPSG at a later date and;

**Whereas,** a third undergraduate student was not selected for the Financial Aid Advisory committee and will be filled by USG at a later date and;

**Whereas,** a second graduate student was not selected for the Financial Aid Advisory committee and will be filled by GPSG at a later date and;

**Whereas,** a professional student was not selected for the Financial Aid Advisory committee and will be filled by GPSG at a later date and;

**Whereas,** a fifth student was not selected for the Hancher Auditorium committee and will be filled by USG and GPSG at a later date and;

**Whereas,** a sixth student was not selected for the Hancher Auditorium committee and will be filled by USG and GPSG at a later date and;

**Whereas,** a fifth student was not selected for the Recreational Service committee and will be filled by USG and GPSG at a later date and;

**Whereas,** a student was not selected for the Athletics committee and will be filled by USG and GPSG at a later date and;

**Whereas,** a graduate student was not selected for the Sustainability committee and will be filled by GPSG at a later date and;

**Whereas,** a professional student was not selected for the Sustainability committee and will be filled by GPSG at a later date.
